AND WHEREAS for the aforesaid purpose the Author of the Trust has set apart a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) from out of his own funds towards the CORPUS OF THE TRUST. At present there is no movable or immovable properties owned by this trust. The trust shall not run any business and it shall not function in the nature of conduction of business activities and not for the purpose of profit.


NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESS AS FOLLOWS

I. NAME

This trust shall be known as **ROJAVANAM** or by any other name as may be decided by the board of trustee.

II. REGISTERED OFFICE

The Registered office of the Trust shall be at Door No.41, Vellalar Colony West, Ramavarmapuram, Nagercoil.1 Kanyakumari District. or any other place/places as decided by the Board of trustees. The registered office will be functioning in the above (Rental Building)

### III. Objects of the Trust

The Trust is a Public Charitable one and will do all acts and deeds that are public charitable in nature as defined under the Income Tax Act 1961. The specific objects for which the Trust is declared:

1. To establish maintain take on lease, conduct and contribute to hospitals, clinics to promote Yoga & Naturopathy, Medical research associations, dispensaries maternity house and other institutions for affording medical relief by way of treatment, cure, rest, recuperation and other relief to the members of the public without the intention of making profit.

2. To establish, conduct maintain take on lease and assist in establishing residential and non residential schools, colleges, workshops and other institutions for imparting general, technical, vocational, professional, industrial or other kinds of education and training for the utility and welfare of the General Public without the intention of making profit.

3. To make pecuniary grants by way of scholarships, donation awards subscription, allowance, guarantee or otherwise to and for the benefit of students, scholars and other persons, in furtherance of education including research.

4. To provide foods, cloths medicines and other articles of necessity free of or at concessional rates and to make money grants to the poor and needy for any purpose whatsoever and to afford to people in distress in general and on occasions of earth quake, floods famine, pestilence and other such causes

5. To encourage conduct research so as to be benefit to the general public.

6. To distribute free of cost or at concessional rate such literature as may be thought conducive for the education of the public.

7. To relieve the poor and indigent men, woman and children of all communities without any restriction as to religion, caste, community or creed by constructing maintaining, community public Halls for the benefit of the public.

8. To establish and maintain research centers for analyzing deterioration in ecology environment biodiversity human animal plants complementarily and energy in life for sustainable livelihood to promote ecological and environmental gradation by and through sustainable agriculture

9. To provide helping hand for health, Education and Economic development of SC/ST people.

10. To propagate and implement population control programmes.

11. To shelter abandoned, deprived Old People by way of establishing Elders Home etc,

12. To implement programmes of Women Empowerment and thus promote their level of dependence socially economically and educationally.

13. To engage in AIDs awareness programmes and STD control programmes etc.,

14. To propagate and implement the importance of Blood donation.

15. To propagate and implement the importance of Eye Donation

16. To conduct camps, Youth programmes and career counselling center, establish health clinics and hospitals to treat inpatients and out patients.

17. To forms centers for development of Indian Medicine and Natural Herbal Medicine and provide treatment thorough these centers also engaging in Research upon subjects.

18. To provide relief measures at the time of natural calamities such as flood fire drought, famine, cyclone earthquake epidemic, storm accidents and pestilence etc.,

19. To conduct periodic lectures meetings, conferences seminars surveys on the matters of Health Agriculture and Ecology

20. To conduct lifestyle management programmes

21. To conduct awareness programmes upon household poisons and home accidents.

22. To propagate the perils of deforestation.
23. To conduct diabetic programs, awareness and control programmes upon Tuberculosis Leprosy, Cancer, Heart Disease and Road Traffic Accidents etc.,
24. To cultivate Herbal plants and trees.
25. To conduct nutrition health programmes for pregnant women and babies and their health problems.
26. To conduct programmes on control on communicable and non communicable diseases.
27. To conduct programmes of occupational hazards and induced diseases.
28. To conduct programmes of prevention and control of pollution.
29. To provide shelters to orphans consisting of abandoned street children of AIDs patients, commercial Sex workers and Destitute.
30. To provide shelter, food, clothes and basic amenities to the poor people who are helpless indeed and make them capable of earning of their own by way of implementing vocational trainings of all natures.
31. To establish and run rural vocational Training center to empower the unemployed youth, both Men and Women, farmers physically challenged and forming Self Help group among them to make them viable in all nature.
32. Providing educational help in the forms of Uniforms, books, school or college fee, hostel fee and help deserved to continue their studies.
33. Establishing centers for physically challenged to equip them in a profitable career and thereby to gibe hem a meaningful life.
34. Running counselling center for delinquent youth, families under marital indifferences, drug addicts etc.,
35. Campaigns on Alcohol, Drug Addiction, Aids awareness, Hygiene conditions of human being etc., and to rehabilitation centre for drug addiction.

36. Assisting farmers of all natures by way of providing trainings, knowledge on their respective fields so as to equip them with all measures to take yields many folds.

37. To engage in Rural Development programmes to render service in the rural areas in all possible ways and promote their welfare and participate in all programmes of central and State Govt and get the benefits offered by the schemes and thus to uplift the neglected areas so as to curb the regional imbalances.

38. To promote the natural cultivation and develop the conventional ways of farming and to devise all the possible ways in the field of agriculture and allied activities to recoup the benefits lost by the modern way of farming.

39. To promote the Rural and urban medical development to make aware of the necessities of medical schemes framed by the Trust and Government and thus to promote the hygienic conditions of the people.

40. To promote wasteland development

41. To conduct training programmes to the farmers on use of natural manure and pesticide and judicious use of water

42. To promote scientific cattle rearing so that the poor farmers and the landless agricultural coolies enhance their family income and avoid migration to the cities.

43. To help people to own their own decent houses.

44. To undertake relevant relief activities during the out breaks of nature and epidemics.

45. To run a hospital or other such institutions for the reception and treatment of persons suffering from illness or mental defectiveness or for reception and treatment of persons during convalescence or of persons requiring medical attention or rehabilitation society for philanthropic purpose and not for any gain or profit.

45. To make awareness programmes of pollution control and propagate its importance.

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46. To establish and run Creches, Nursery Schools, Colleges and Training centers for the upliftment of the rural folks.

47. To conduct Homes for children for the poor and destitute children (both boys and girls) and provide them with boarding education, medical and recreational facilities with a view to raising their socio economic standards and encouraging national integration.

48. To organise village economy for self sufficiency through self employment in agriculture cattle rearing dairy, goat rearing, poultry farming and village industries.


49. To take part in welfare activities organised and sponsored by the Government within the capacity of the Trust for promoting sustainable development for the socially, economically and educationally downtrodden

50. To apply for and obtain assistance including loans from the Government and other organisation and financial institutions NGOs Bank central state Govt Corporations, Companies firms or individuals both National and international for developing all or any of the program or programs of the Trust for the welfare of the economically socially and educationally downtrodden people of India.

51. To undertake programmes to eliminate child labour and protect the rights of children for education and recreation and social security.

52. To undertake environmental and ecology programs through organising seminars, workshops and conference to all sections of the population for protecting our environment through ecological agriculture.

53. To conduct orientation programmes for social workers on basic law of our nation in order to make them understand law of the land and to stream line their action for protection of human rights for all sections of the population who are suffering due to violation of Human rights.

54. To establish local need based community life experience center, in order to function as center of school education including study groups task forces seminars workshops and such other activities which would promote Social understanding and serve as a forum for placement and evaluation and to initiate and organize local based economic projects to save as (i) Training (ii) Research (iii) Experiment (iv) Support and maintain the expanding activities of the trust.

55. To publish journals, broacher, pamphlets, books etc for promoting the above aims and objects for private circulation.

56. To receive help through communication, membership, net work, friendship like minded people in the national international level.

57. To co ordinate with the government and financial institutions to promote the objects and or help such institutions in any other manner.

58. To give the children to buy their books and notebooks and to pay them fees and grant scholarship to them.

59. To educate moral standard through multimedia.


60. To work in co-ordination with any other trust or institution having good aims and objects aid assists and undertake in any other manner.

61. It is declared that the benefits of the trust shall be open to all irrespective of Caste, creed, colour, religion community etc.,

62. To do all such things as may be necessary for the furtherance of the above objects of the trust, but shall not include activities for profit.


63. It is agreed that the income and contribution that to be acquired in future shall be spent towards the promotion of the trust and any incidental work connected and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to trustees by way of Profit interest dividend etc.,

64. The activities of the Trust will not be carried out outside India.

65. To uplift and provide physical, Social, Psychological, educational, economical support to the people and children who are infected and affected by HIV/AIDS and to facilitate and motivate the Adults and children for socialization through institutional and community based support.
66. To mobilize the community to involve in the children care and to identify the children's skills and impart special training for them.
67. To take care of charitable, Medical Educational, Economical and social activities for the benefit of the poor and needy irrespective of caste, creed, religion, sex and status.
68. To give support and promote education in all branches of knowledge and training including physical, moral, spiritual and social development of persons of any level of age by establishing and running of schools colleges and institutions.
69. To subscribe aid, donate to or subsidize any work, organizations of institutions to work jointly with other organizations or institutions in promotions of the objectives of the trust.
70. To enable the most marginalized people to organize themselves into Self-supportive Sangams (SSS) so as to decide their own micro level development.
71. To motivate the self employed men and women to form themselves in to marginal traders and co operatives in order to increase their collective bargaining power.
72. To offer alternative employment skill training to the young men and women in order to enhance their capability for self employment.
73. To initiate the process to empowerment of women through self help schemes.
74. To organize periodical training and coaching classes for uneducated young women in tailoring, home management, home products and other related fields so as to improve their life style.

75. To engage in programmes of education in general and in particular crèches, Balwadi, Primary and non formal technical education for development
76. To provide medical facilities and orphanages to the poor and also provide necessary aid and help to the aged and disabled.
77. To undertake research and investigation in the problems of scientific, economic, environment, health, legal consumer, protection, human rights etc for social development.
78. To act as a resource centre for research, training, documentation and consultancy for social development.
79. To run, establish educational institutions, workshops, training institutes health or educational centres to achieve the objects of the trust.
80. To establish Palliative care centre.

#### IV. CONSTITUTION

1. **MR.R.ARUL KANNAN AND MR.R.ARUL JOTHI** shall be the Managing Trustees of the trust and they shall be entitled to continue as such during his life time.
2. The Managing Trustees, shall hold their office for their life time.
3. The number of trustees shall not exceed twelve at anytime.
4. The Managing trustees are vested with the power to induct new trustees or remove existing trustees on the board of trustees.
5. In the case of death, resignation etc the trustees, the Managing Trustee has the power to appoint any person in his/her place as trustee.

#### V. MANAGEMENT

1. Subject to provision herein the Board of Trustees shall be entitled to exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as are necessary to carry out the above mentioned objects.
2. The Board of trustees shall meet at least once a year for approving the statement of accounts.
3. The Board of trustees shall act as a man of ordinary prudence with care and interest in discharging duties diligently and faithfully for the greatest advantage to achieve the objectives of the trust.

4. They should not act in deterioration to the name and assets of the Trust. If any loss accrues because of the dishonest and carelessness of the trustees, then he/she should be personally liable for such loss or losses.

5. If a trustee is proved by appropriate evidence as dishonest and or his/her activities are proved to be against the interest of the trust then the Board of trustee may serve notice of termination on his/her after calling for his/her explanation.

6. The Board shall be entitled to make and prescribe from time to time any rules and bye-laws and regulations for carrying the objectives of the trust and also modify or amend such bye laws and regulations for carrying the objectives of the trust within the frame work of the trust.

7. The Board of Trustees have power to start, establish branches anywhere in India and the branch has to function as per the rules and regulations as framed by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

#### VI. MEETING OF THE BOARD

1. In addition to the annual meeting, the Board may meet from time to time.

2. The Managing Trustees shall be the Directors of the Board of Trustees and they will preside over the meeting.

3. The Board shall transact any business that may be specified in the Agenda or otherwise agreed to by the Board members.

4. One half of the Board members, or two members whichever is higher shall constitute the quorum.

5. All decision shall be carried out by the majority decision of the Board, but in the events or equality of votes, the chairman presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.

6. Any resolution in writing signed by all the trustees shall be binding on the Board as through it had been passed at a meeting of the Board of trustees.

7. The meeting of the Board shall e convened after giving at least to accept a shorter notice.

8. The Managing Trustees may invite others interested in the work of the Trust to attend the meetings of the Board but they shall not be entitled to vote there.

9. All decisions shall be carried out by the majority decision of the Board.

#### VII. BANK ACCOUNT

Bank account can be opened in the name of the trust in any of the Private Bank, Nationalized, Scheduled, Co-operative, Regional Rural Banks or other banks of Financial Institutions as the Managing Trustees decide from time to time. The Managing Trustees **Mr.R.Arul Kannan and Mr.R.Arul Jothi** shall operate the said account jointly.

#### VIII. INVESTMENT OF THE TRUST FUNDS AND DEVELOPMENT OF TRUST

1. The Board shall have power to invest the Corpus or the income from the trust fund at their discretion in accordance with the provisions of section 13(1) (d) read with sec.11(5) of the Income tax Act 1961.

2. The Board shall have power to collect funds from individuals and organizations like state and central government institution.

3. Trustees may collect further contributions in cash or kind towards its Corpus Fund or General Fund or Capital Fund or Revenue Fund or Earmarked Fund or any other Specific Fund.

4. Where the income and other receipts exceeds the expenditure of the Trust the Surplus funds may be transferred to Corpus Fund or General Fund or Capital Fund or Revenue Fund or Earmarked Fund or any other specified fund.

#### IX. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

The financial year of the trust shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March. The accounts of the trust shall be maintained regularly and annually audited by a chartered Accountant appointed by the board of trustees and the audited statement of account shall be placed before the board for its approval within six months from the close of the financial year.

**X. Custody of Documents:**

The Founder of the Trust or his nominees may have the custody of all documents and Files containing deeds relating to the trust and its properties. They are responsible for the preservation of such documents and deeds.

**XI. Advisory Body and Committee:**

- a. The board of Trustees may appoint experts and advisers to secure their services and to get their advice to further the objects of the Trust.
- b. The board of Trustees may appoint committee or committees and entrust with them powers to execute or administer the projects that may have been undertaken by the Board while carrying out the objects of the Trust. The necessary expenditures may be met by the Trust.

**XII. Minutes:**

- a. The trustees shall cause proper minutes to be kept and entered in a book provided or the purpose of all their resolutions and proceedings and any such minutes of any meeting of the trustees, if purporting to be signed by the chairman of such meeting or by the Chairman of the next succeeding meeting shall be receivable as prima facie evidence of the matters stated in such minutes.

**b Applicability:**

The Activities of the trust are open to citizens of India without any distinction of religion, caste, creed, sex, place of birth or any of them and are not expressed to be for the benefit of any individual or community.

**C. Staff**

The Board has power to appoint employees of the Trust and to pay and give allowance to such persons.

**D. Arbitration**

The trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits and other proceedings and settle difference and disputes touching the trust property and to refer any such difference or disputes to arbitration and to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the trust property and to do all other act, things fully and effectually without being liable or answerable for any bonafide loss occasioned there by.

**E. Execution**


The trustees shall have the power to arrange for and or authorize the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustees by the author of the trust or any trustee authorized by the author of the trust in writing to make the same effective and binding as if the said agreement, contract, instrument or document or paper or writing were signed by all the trustees.

**XIII. AMENDMENTS**

1. The trust shall irrevocable.
2. If any alternation or amendments were necessary the same shall be effected through supplementary deed/deeds with the previous approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax and it shall be read together with this main deed such amendments will no be repugnant to the provisions of the Income tax Act. Such amendments shall not in the nature of altering the basic objectives of the trust.



**XIV. DISSOLUTION**

In the event of dissolution of this trust, the entire trust fund shall be realized and first to be used for payment of liabilities of the trust. The assets left if any shall be disbursed to other trust or association having similar object which enjoy recognition under section 80G of the Income Tax Act if this trust enjoys that exemption and in no event it shall be appropriate either be the trustees or by any one related to the Trustees. At present this trust has no movable or immovable properties in its name.
